



1. The first step in the recycling process is to collect and sort the waste. This is done by separating different types of materials into different streams. For example, paper, plastic, and metal are each collected separately. This is done to ensure that each material can be recycled properly.

2. The next step is to process the materials. This involves breaking down the materials into their basic components. For example, paper is pulped, plastic is melted, and metal is smelted. This process is done to create a raw material that can be used to make new products.

3. The final step is to manufacture new products. This is done by combining the raw materials with other resources to create new products. For example, recycled paper is used to make new paper products, recycled plastic is used to make new plastic products, and recycled metal is used to make new metal products.
